



Numerous internships related to app development, machine learning, artificial intelligence, cloud computing, and web development have been completed by students in the healthcare program at the hospital as well as by students from other programs in the industry, such as engineering at TCS iON, THDC, BHEL, Diginique Tech Labs, IBM, etc. Biomedical engineering students can also complete an internship or practical training at the Himalayan Hospital on campus. Students in other programs also go through this kind of interactive, hands-on, and real learning.




